And now we'll stop, because the real fun begins on the next page. Enjoy reading! That's what everyone here wishes you, as you browse all we have here waiting for you.
















THE BAREISS ANIMAL WORLD FOR YOU!

Watch, approach, and sharpen your senses – animals are simply fascinating and are a true gift to us humans. We can learn so much by spending time with them. Did you know that horses are highly attuned to your feelings and can mirror your behaviour? That rabbits are prey animals and can move their ears independently in all directions? Or that in a goat herd, every member has a role, and those who don't follow the rules get into trouble?

Animals meet us without prejudice. How they organise themselves within their groups and communicate without words is something you can observe not only in our petting zoo but also in the fallow deer herd, the beehives at Morlokhof, and at the »Forellenhof Buhlbach«. Plus, there's a feeding station at the fish pond in the Forest Park, where you can help feed the fish. The daily ration is carefully measured – once the box is empty, please come back another time.

THE PETTING ZOO


Five cheeky ponies and a horse, playful pygmy goats and a growing rabbit family - this lively bunch call our petting zoo their home. They are all very tame and curious but they do also have a mind of their own. And that is a good thing as it tells you very quickly whether they are feeling well or whether they are not happy with something.

You know that you should always be careful when dealing with animals and approach them gently so as to avoid scaring them. It is no secret either that they like to nibble at everything which appears in front of their noses. And they know no limits to their own appetite. Snacking between meals isn't a good idea, so we'll prepare their meals together.

Bea, Bibiana and Bless are our classic ponies - they look so alike you'll hardly be able tell them apart! The other three - grey mare Lucy, chestnut Tabasco and the Black Forest chestnut Irmi - can be recognised from afar.

Our bunnies are all little »rascals« and know how to rope others in. When they come closer to you, this shows that they are curious. The best idea is to first allow them to sniff the palm of your hand.

Our African pygmy goats are the smallest breed of goats in the world. Plants grow rather sparsely and the climate is dry in their home countries. In the wilderness, they have to cope with this on their own and that's why they are such undemanding and compact animals.





THE FALLOW DEER ENCLOSURE

Fallow deer have a sociable character and like being in large herds. However, the stags and females move out in separate groups outside the mating season. They are rather shy and use their eyes, ears and nose to spot any danger in plenty of time. You can tell what mood they are in by their tail: If it is hanging down loosely or wagging a little, everything is fine. If they sense danger, it will be horizontal – and if they are on the run, it will point upwards. When they are running from danger you will see them doing so-called bounce jumps, in which they take off from the ground with all four legs at the same time. They do this to demonstrate their strength in order to drive away any predators.

QUITE CLEVER!


As they can make good use even of a frugal diet, fallow deer are not choosy when it comes to food and will even eat wild scrubs. So our animals are also perfect landscape conservationists and take good care of our hilly terrain. That is quite a clever arrangement nature has devised, isn't it?

BEEKEEPING

From May to September, you can take a closer look at our bees - and maybe even see them swarming if you're lucky! In a bee colony, each bee has its own special role. The queen is the only fertile female; she goes on a nuptial flight with the drones and lays the eggs. Afterwards she is looked after by an army of perfectly organised workers so that she can concentrate fully on her task. Amongst the workers there are cleaners, nurses, maids, guards, heaters, aerators, scouts, collectors - yes, and even an alarm standby reserve. It's no wonder that beehives are buzzing with activity.

THE »FORELLENHOF«

What do fish like? In which environment do they feel most comfortable? How can we make sure that herons don't catch them? In our trout farm, you can find out first-hand what rainbow trout, salmon trout, golden trout and char need in order to flourish. Our fish farmers will take you on a tour of the facilities and show you how the flow channel basin, hatchery, technical building and filter systems work. It's not so much about the fishing as it is about the fish themselves. You can learn how to distinguish between different species, find out where they get their names from and why trout don't like »lazing around«.



The honey you can savour for breakfast comes from our bees living at the Morlokhof. With a little luck, you may even see the queen when you look into the beehive at the display panel.



WHAT DO YOU KNOW ABOUT FISH?

Our fish farmers have come up with a great idea to get you hooked. You can take out your Explorer's Diploma with them, and become a junior expert. You should definitely not miss out on this bait, there is no hook or string attached.




PILLOW ROOM






BUTTERFLY

If you keep your eyes, ears and nose open, nature will reward you with fascinating little wonders. If you want to know what it's like underground or high up in the treetops, you should definitely plan a visit to our National Park Centre. A fascinating experience awaits you here, immerse yourself in the forest wilderness and – thanks to computer animation – you can experience what's it like to glide over the national park with a falcon.





Some birds build the nests outdoors while others prefer moving into a perfect home. Ask one of our nesting box professionals to show you how to build a perfect house for a bird family. If everyone participates, you will have a whole village of them. And, maybe, you will also take home one of them.



WHITE-THROATED DIPPER A bird that can swim, dive, and even walk underwater: the white-throated dipper uses its wings like flippers. It's even mastered a silent secret language: it blinks to communicate with others of

its kind.



THREE-TOED WOODPECKER

For this insect hunter, bark beetles and their larvae are a delicacy. It therefore prefers areas with plenty of deadwood and, thanks to its preferred diet, helps to naturally support the health of the forest in our national park.



FLYING BIRDS

You are fascinated by birds of prey, and admire their acrobatic flight manoeuvres? Do you also know how to identify a buzzard, a red kite and a hawk? If so, you will have a great time with our expert Achim Klumpp, and, with a little luck, he will also take you to a rescue centre if an animal happens to be there for feeding up.

GREY PARTRIDGE

The grey partridge is the »Bird of the Year 2026«, succeeding the black redstart. It belongs to the pheasant family, lives on farmland and can be heard calling at dawn and dusk. You can recognise the male's territorial call by its rough, rasping »girrhehk«.

GIANT SLIDE

The **Poppeltal giant slide** is the longest and fastest summer toboggan run in Germany: over 1,500 metres of thrilling downhill track with steep bends. Other attractions include a children's mountain railway, bumper cars and trampolines.













TRAVELLING ON YOUR OWN

In and around Baiersbronn, you have almost endless possibilities for discovering new things all the time. You can go for excursions into the open countryside, go to cultural events or learn about history. Giant vantage points allow views into the distance, to the stars and even into the future. You can explore scientific trails, jump into cold water, and turn big wheels. Fabulous treasures are waiting to be recovered. Just try and find these seven destinations on the map.





The Lothar Trail in Baiersbronn takes you over footbridges, ladders and stairs through a wild forest area swept down by the gusts of Cyclone Lothar. Nobody has come here to tidy this up as nature is regenerating itself, leading to the stunning results you can see today.



Explore the Black Forest, find new paths, and set your own goals: At the »Bareiss Aktiv« bike station, e-bikes are available for hire (for a fee) for teens and Maxis from 9 years of age. Helmets, water bottles, and paniers are, of course, also provided.

NATIONAL PARK CENTRE

Make your way into the deep thicket, descend into the earth, and feel like a beetle yourself: At the Ruhestein National Park Centre, the forest becomes its own storyteller, and invites you to a multimedia meet-up with the animal and plant kingdoms.



Making butter, weaving baskets, or binding brushwood bind, this open-air museum located in Gutach brings back farm life as it used to be 600 years ago as »Menne«, the museum's mascot playfully introduces you to an exciting past. History you can touch, not covered in dust by any means.





UNIMOG MUSEUM

The Unimog Museum in Gaggenau is a great transport and technology museum which is really second to none. You can gaze at an impressive parade of four-wheeled all-terrain juggernauts, have a look under their bonnets and learn everything about their technology.





Take a **bullcart** and use the T-bar lift to go up the steep slope leading to the Mehliskopf/Bühl mountain station before you start your downhill race. These 3 wheeled carts have thick slanted tyres which make for ultimate driving fun and a rising pulse. Only flying is more beautiful.



Out into the snow!

When winter comes and thick snowflakes are falling, nature retreats under white and glittery cotton wool for a while. Giant glass cones grow downward from roofs, ice flowers appear on windows and frosty pearl necklaces wind themselves around the trees. This is really gorgeous to look at and also makes for blissful pleasures. Have you ever gone on a hike walking on snowshoes or built an igloo? A cup of hot chocolate is waiting to warm you up afterwards.

If you like to do more sports and would like to let off steam while skiing either downhill or cross-country, you will be interested in learning about the ski lifts located at Ruhestein and at Seibelseckle along the Black Forest High Road. These are our regional hotspots for skiers and snowboarders. These areas are really suitable for everyone and allow you to make downhill runs on levels of difficulty which vary considerably. But you can also take your toboggan by the horns and bomb down the track to have real fun. Take care and avoid losing speed or tipping over, which is not exactly as easy as it might look. But, once you get the hang of it, all you need is a free track and: Yippee, off you go!




FUN ON THE SLOPES

BERTI'S BEAR BISCUITS

220 g butter | 175 g sugar | 1 egg | 1 packet vanilla sugar | pinch of salt | 175 g flour | 75 g ground almonds | a knife tip of baking powder | 3 tbsp cocoa | 100 g dark chocolate | chopped almonds

Mix all ingredients except the dark chocolate into a firm dough. If it's too sticky, add a little more flour. Shape the dough into two rolls about 4 cm thick and chill in the fridge for one hour.





Preheat the oven to 170°C. Line a baking tray with parchment paper. Slice the rolls into 0.5 cm rounds and place on the tray. Use a fork to draw lines across the biscuits.

Bake for 12–15 minutes, then cool thoroughly. Melt the chocolate, dip one half of each biscuit in it, and press four almond slivers into the coating as claws.

Let them dry well – then crunch and enjoy!

YOU'LL NEED:

- · 1 white paper plate (Ø 20 cm)
- Brown and beige acrylic paint
- Paintbrush
- · Small craft scissors
- . Tracing paper
- · Pencil
- . Brown and pink felt
- · Glue stick or glue gun
- . string

Step 1

Paint the back of the paper plate brown and let it dry completely.



Step 2

Trace the templates for hair, outer and inner ears, cheeks and nose onto parchment paper using a pencil and cut them out.

Transfer the hair and outer ears (2x) onto brown felt, the nose onto black felt, and the cheeks (2x) and inner ears (2x) onto pink felt, then cut them out.











Step 3

Glue the inner and outer ears together, stick the hair to the front of the plate, and attach the ears at the back on either side.



Step 4

Mark and cut out the eyes. Paint the bear's muzzle in beige below, let it dry, and glue on the black nose.



Step 5

Glue on the cheeks. Mark small points on the left and right edges of the plate and cut them out. Cut two pieces of string, each about 30 cm long, thread one end through each hole and secure the ends with a knot.
