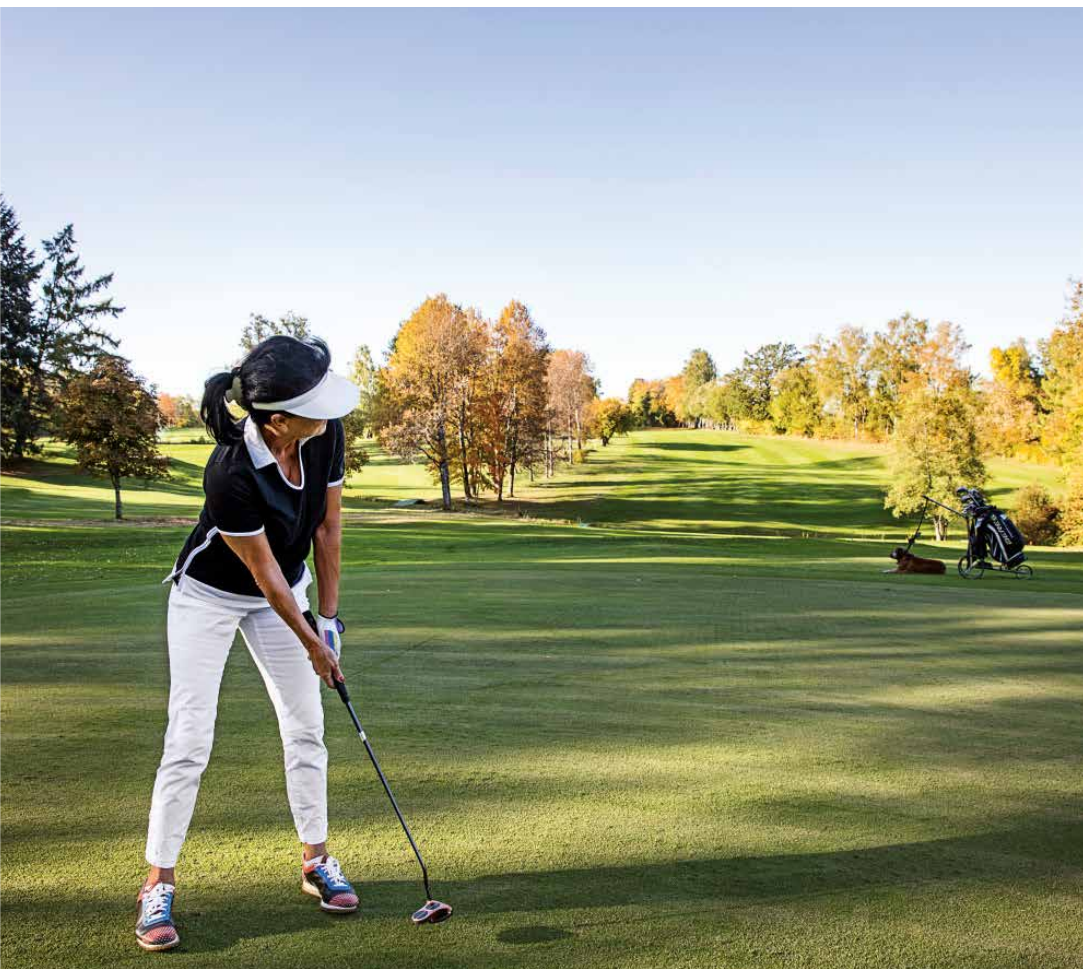
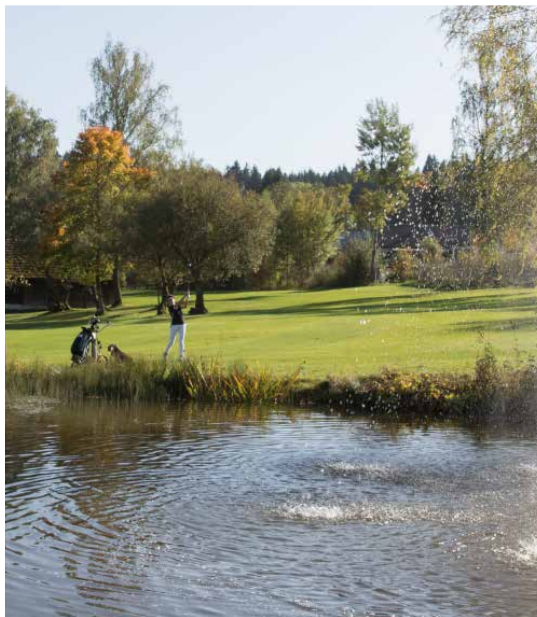

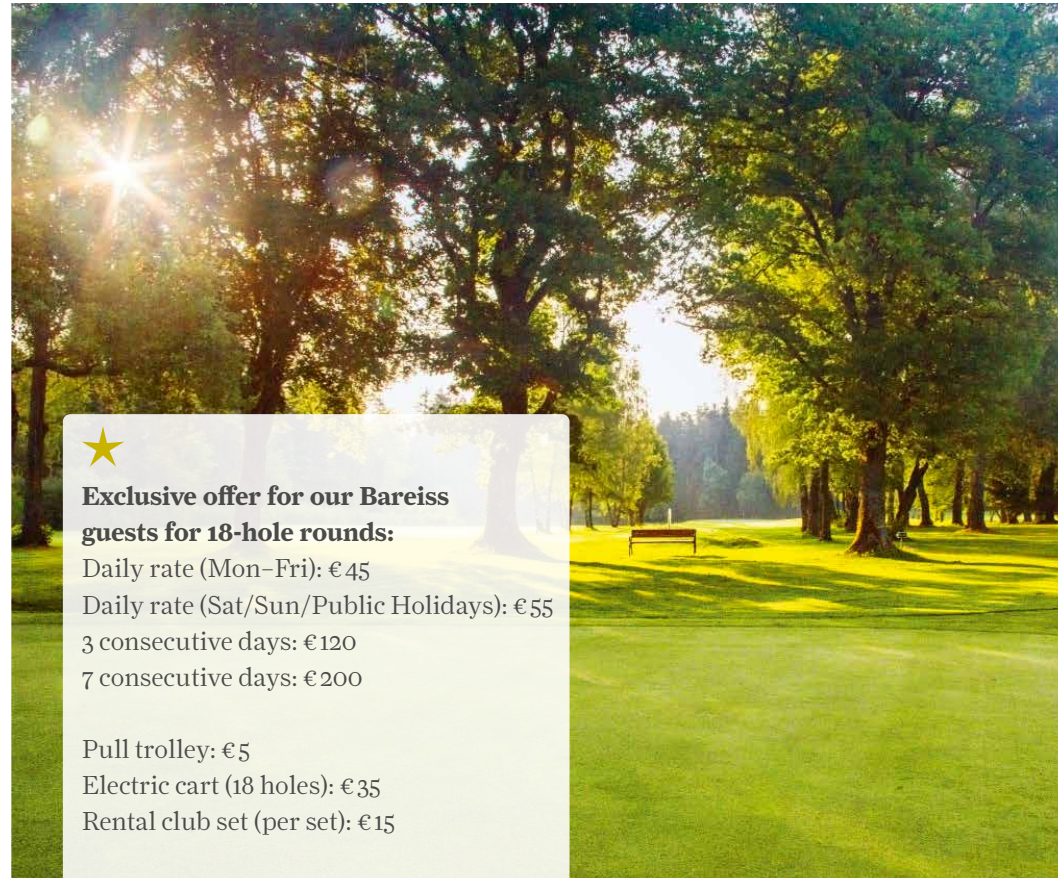

Out-and-about diversity

» »Golfing in a park« is the creed of the **Baden-Baden Golf Club**. Although the course »only« has a par of 64, it also demonstrates its refinement for those with low handicaps, and is a welcome challenge compared to many modern courses that are long, wide and flat. For golfers, playing a round in Baden-Baden is comparable to an classic car fan taking part in the Mille Miglia Rally. Bareiss guests receive a **discount of € 10** off the green fee.

» **Soufflenheim Golf Club** is located in an enchantingly peaceful environment surrounded by forest, far from any stress or noise. 33 greens and 18 lakes, some newly created, are harmonically embedded in the tranquil wetland landscape. A purely natural experience and a masterpiece created by German golf professional Bernhard Langer. Bareiss guests receive a **20 % green fee discount**.

» **Königsfeld Golf Club** is located in the hilly landscape of the Black Forest, on the edge of the health resort of Königsfeld, where Albert Schweitzer lived with his family. You are bound to feel good here. At the Golf Club you can switch off while enjoying your round of golf far from traffic or airplane noise and surrounded by nature.
